








Participate.












ORIGAMI MARTLET


Have fun creating your own origami martlet (or two!) with the easy step-by-step guide shown on the next page. Post a photo of your creation on social media.








Put the coloured side of the paper face down. Fold the paper in half and then unfold it.




Fold the top layer of paper to the left - more than halfway down - along the dotted line.




Fold the paper along the dotted line and then unfold it.




Fold the paper in half the other way.




Fold the model in half along the dotted line.




Using the crease from the previous step, fold the tip inward to form the beak.



Fold both layers of paper to the right – a little more than halfway down – along the dotted line.



Fold the top flap of paper up along the dotted line. Repeat on the other side.
